Gateway Longview's Adopt-an-Angel program provides Christmas gifts for children and families in our care. Year after year, we're thankful for the many businesses, churches, and community groups whose gifts and support offer holiday cheer for hundreds of children in Western New York. Each gift leaves a lasting impact for our youth, from preschool through high school, to teens and young adults.

Here's How it Works:

Holiday "Wish Lists" from our children and families will be provided to you by email in early November, along with other program details and gift guidelines. We ask that you spend as much or as little as you are comfortable with, generally \$75-\$100 per child. This year, gifts can be dropped off in early December, at Angel Headquarters, on our campus at 6350 Main Street, in Williamsville, at our maintenance building.

Sadly, we often fall short on gifts for **"Teen Angels,"** or those ages 13-19. The holidays can be a difficult time for teens, especially those living in our residential cottages away from family and friends. If you are interested in supporting these youth, a list of on-going needs is available. Some examples include winter gear (gloves, hats, etc.), sports equipment, video games, headphones, chapter books/book series, journals, hygiene products, socks & undergarments, blankets, and Amazon, Walmart or Target gift cards.
